

Mediterranean Film Festival Split will be held for the fourth time in the city of Split (Croatia); 1700 years old Mediterranean town, from June 11th - June 18th 2011. The festival will screen 30 feature and short films from the Mediterranean region in the main competition. The screenings will be held outdoors and indoors; in an open-air cinema Bacvice and in a cinema Zlatna Vrata in the center of the Diocletian's palace.
